Part A – New Player to the GTHL

- **Required Information for Minor Atom to Minor Bantam**
 - a) **Completed Hockey Canada Registration Certificate**
 - b) **Copy of Player's Birth Certificate**
 - c) **OHF Lake Ontario Region (L.O.R) Permission to Skate Form if the Player was registered within an OMHA L.O.R club in the previous season**
 - d) **If residing in an extension or outside the L.O.R, Player can only tryout and register with an AAA club with the necessary waivers or PTS depending on residency (Please refer to Section C)**

- **Required Information for Bantam to U21 AAA**
 - a) **Completed Hockey Canada Registration Certificate**
 - b) **Copy of Player's Birth Certificate**
 - c) **OHF Lake Ontario Region (L.O.R) Permission to Skate Form if the Player was registered within an OMHA L.O.R club in the previous season**
 - d) **Release from previous team**
 - e) **If residing in an extension or outside the L.O.R, Player can only tryout and register with an AAA club with the necessary waivers or PTS or PTS and release. (Please refer to Section C). This does not apply to U21 AAA teams as Players in this age group must reside within the L.O.R**



Part B – Returning Player to the GTHL

■ Required Information for Minor Atom to Minor Bantam

- a) Completed Hockey Canada Registration Certificate
- b) If residing outside the L.O.R, trying out and registering in AAA with a different GTHL AAA Organization to the previous year, then the necessary waivers must be renewed
- c) If residing outside the L.O.R, trying out and registering in AAA while staying with his current AAA Organization for the upcoming season and is going to his next Major age group (Atom to Minor Pee wee, Pee wee to Minor Bantam, Bantam to Minor Midget), then all necessary waivers must be renewed

■ Required Information for Bantam to U21 AAA

- a) Completed Hockey Canada Registration Certificate
- b) Release from previous team if the Player is not registering with the same Organization from the previous season
- c) If residing outside the L.O.R, trying out and registering with a different AAA Organization to the previous year, then the necessary waivers must be renewed
- d) If residing outside the L.O.R, trying out and registering in AAA while staying with his current AAA Organization for the upcoming season and is going to his next Major age group (Atom to Minor Pee wee, Pee wee to Minor Bantam, Bantam to Minor Midget), then all necessary waivers must be renewed. This does not apply to U21 AAA teams as Players within this age group must reside within the L.O.R

Part C - Lake Ontario Region and Outside

- Within the Lake Ontario Region

Toronto (GTHL centre)

Ajax-Pickering, Brampton, Oakville, Richmond Hill (OMHA centre)

Players residing in the above OMHA centers are Imports to any GTHL club and are eligible to participate at the A, AA and AAA level.

Markham - Players who reside in this area are Non-Imports to any GTHL club UNLESS they participated with the Markham Waxers of the OMHA in the previous season. Players in this situation would be Imports to any GTHL club with the exception of the Markham Islanders and Markham Majors. In order for a Player in this instance to lose his Import status, the Player must participate with the Islanders or Majors for one (1) full season.



Part C – Lake Ontario Region and Beyond

- Extensions of the Lake Ontario Region and outside the Lake Ontario Region.

Players who reside in extensions of the Lake Ontario Region are only permitted to tryout and register with a AAA Club in the GTHL with appropriate PTS or PTS and release depending on age group.

Players who reside outside the Lake Ontario Region, are eligible to tryout and participate at the AAA level only in the GTHL when they have all the required waivers.

For information as it pertains to what waivers are required for Players residing in specific centres, please contact the GTHL registrar.



Part C - Maximum number of Imports A, AA, AAA

- A and AA teams are permitted a maximum of 3 Imports per team. Imports from within Lake Ontario Region only. (Brampton, Ajax-Pickering, Oakville, Richmond Hill) Those Markham residents that are coming from the Markham Waxers of the OMHA would be Imports to any team in the GTHL except the Markham Islanders and Markham Majors.
- AAA teams are permitted a maximum of 5 Imports per team. Imports are permitted from within Lake Ontario Region, extensions of the Lake Ontario Region (Caledon, Stouffville, Nobleking) and Waiver areas.
- U21 AAA teams are permitted 5 Imports. Those Imports can only come from those residencies within the Lake Ontario Region only.
